Guidelines for Show

* **Animals exhibiting fungus, soremouth or other contagious diseases are not allowed to show. Health Inspector has final say at check in point.**

* No goats are allowed in the barn or show area until they are checked in by the health inspector.

* Showmanship class for ages 4-19

* Open to 4-Hers from any county

* All goats must have USDA Scrapie ID tags or registered through breed association (Have paperwork at check-in)

* You may show from pens or trailer

* Market goats will show in the weight class they are assigned

* If using pens bring own bedding

* You are responsible for cleaning out the pen at the conclusion of the show
