

Disposal Directions

The following directions are being provided to assist you in completing this form. Please follow these directions to minimize the Multi-County Solid Waste Task Force/Clean Sweep costs and provide you with the best service possible.

If you have questions on how to complete this form or if you have materials that don't seem to fit the directions, please call your local county coordinator for additional help.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. Estimate weights and volumes as accurately as possible, but do not endanger anyone's health.
2. Please indicate if the product is LIQUID or SOLID.
3. Check to see if the item needs to be repackaged before transporting. Place an X next to the name of a product that may need to be repackaged.
If you place a X next to an item indicating it will need repackaging, we will contact you and work with you to provide repackaging materials or an over pack barrel if necessary. Don't hesitate to call if there is any question.
4. Return this form to the address on the front.
5. All information provided on this form will be kept confidential by your collection coordinator.

Example:

ROSE DUST	1 POUND BOX	0.75 POUNDS	

In this example, please note:

* The paint is in a one gallon container and the "X" indicates that the person feels it may need to be repackaged.

** The antifreeze is in gallons and this person has a total of 4 gallons in one-gallon containers. It is important for the disposal contractor to know what size the container is.
