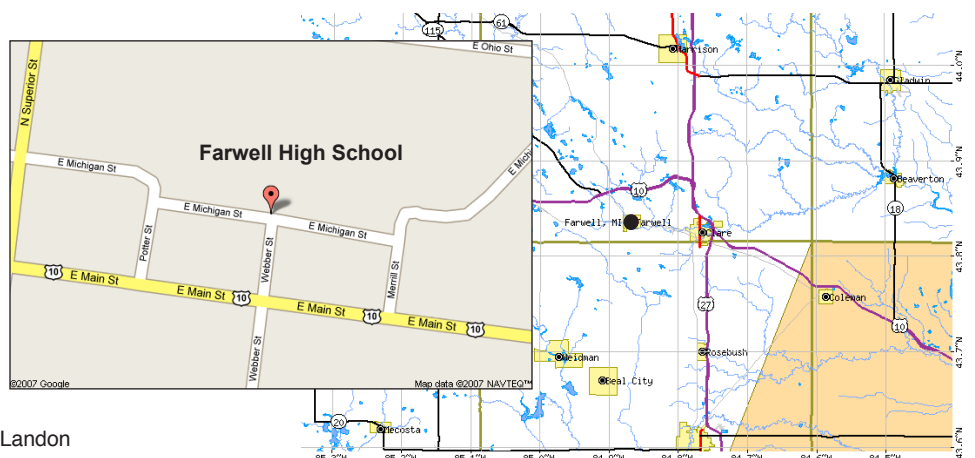

Show Rules

1. This is a carry case show. Coops will not be provided. Carrying cases must have leak proof bottoms. NO STRAW allowed in building. No tables available.
2. Cloverbuds (5 to 8 year olds) can participate in showmanship class, but no breed classes. The Clare County 4-H Small Animal Association will be following the State 4-H Age Policy.
3. Rabbits and cavies will be judged by the current ARBA standards. Pre-juniors will be accepted in breeds as recognized by the ARBA. No mixed breeds. All unrecognized breeds must have a working standard.
4. Animals must be entered in proper breed, color, sex and class. All entries must be made by 8:00 a.m.
5. Exhibitors may enter in as many breeds as they wish and may enter as many animals as they wish.
6. All animals must have a legible and permanent earmark. Cavies may have an ear tag.
7. Exhibitors must be present for showing their animals and are responsible for transporting their animals to and from the show table. Each exhibitor who is showing more than one breed at the same time may have another youth exhibitor help show.
8. No classes will be re-judged due to late arrivals.
9. All animals must be shown in their natural state. No trimming, plucking, or otherwise altering the normal appearance of the animal.
10. Animals showing signs of illness/disease will be removed from the showroom.
11. The Clare County 4-H Small Animal Association and/or the property owners are not responsible for losses due to theft, fire, accident, etc. However, every precaution will be taken to eliminate any danger or mistake in the showroom.
12. Exhibitors will be allowed to advertise and sell their stock during the show.
13. Animals will be released upon the completion of judging of the breed. However, we suggest that all BOB winners stay for the judging of the Best 4 Class and Best 6 Class.
14. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are permitted on school property. NO SMOKING allowed on school property.
15. Showmanship will be judged first - Cloverbuds, 5-8 years, Junior, 9-11 years, Intermediate, 12-14 years, Senior, 15-19 years (age to be determined as of January 1, 2009).
16. Educational Poster must be on poster board or display boards. Should focus on educating first-year or non rabbit members of all ages. Age divisions will be same as showmanship classes.
